



# 2022 Large Waste Policy

Due to the increased volume of regular and large waste and increase in transportation fees, the municipality is enacting the following large waste drop off policy.

**Anything not able to fit in a tied garbage bag is considered large waste and will no longer be picked up.**

Large waste will **NOW ONLY** be accepted **at the drop off site** located at **499 route 301 (chemin du Depotoir)** between the hours of **10 a.m. and 2 p.m.** on the dates stated below.

- ✗ Concrete blocks
- ✗ Tare paper
