BY LAW NUMBER 2023-002: WASTE MANAGEMENT & COMPOSTING BY-LAW

WHEREAS By Law 2023-002 was presented at the **January 16, 2023**, Council meeting and a motion of notice was given by Councillor: Darryl Mayer

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of Alleyn and Cawood want to offer an improved waste management system to their ratepayers;

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of Alleyn and Cawood will introduce a new policy of waste removal and now offer a composting service;

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of Alleyn & Cawood would like to encourage recycling and composting in order to receive financial benefits, such as grants from provincial government as well, the municipality pays less money per ton for recycling and composting as apposed to household garbage;

WHEREAS the Municipality has purchased a standard size garbage truck and will provide bins for household waste (garbage), recycling and composting that will be distributed to all residents with a building or trailer on their property.

ARTICLE ONE: the Municipality will distribute garbage, recycling and composting bins to each property with a building or trailer. Each residential property will

receive one of each bin and a commercial property will receive two of each bin if required. Each property will be able to purchase additional bins at a cost of \$100 for garbage bin, \$100 for recycle bin and \$80 for a composting bin. If in the event a bin is destroyed, damaged or stolen, it is the responsibility of the ratepayer to replace the bin. You cannot provide

your own bin; it has to be a bin provided by the Municipality.

ARTICLE TWO: the Municipality will no long pickup garbage bags that are not inside the

household waste bins. All bags (both household waste & recycling) must be inside the appropriate container to ensure that no bags are torn open by

animals or birds.

ARTICLE THREE: the Municipal garbage truck will service private roads to continue our waste removal service however, the road must be a minimum of 12 feet wide with a turnround that is a minimum 40 feet diameter at the end of the

wide with a turnround that is a minimum 40 feet diameter at the end of the road, in order for the garbage truck to safely navigate the road. All private

roads must be maintained in summer and winter. If any of these conditions are not followed waste removal services will be terminated until the situation is rectified. If the garbage truck cannot safely travel on any private road, the municipality will create / excavate an area at an intersection of the private road, where ratepayers can bring their bins for pickup.

ARTICLE FOUR:

the Municipality will publish annually a Waste Management Calendar indicating when each pickup will be scheduled. Garbage and recycling pickups will be weekly. Composting will be picked up weekly for the months of May to October then they will switch to a by-weekly pickup for the months of November to April.
