Borrowing By-Law (By-Law #002-2016)

By-Law number 002-2016 is to enact an expense of \$432,471.88 and a loan of \$432,471.88 for the resurfacing treatment on Harrison Road.

WHEREAS notice of motion of this by-law was given at the Council meeting held on 11 March 2016.

The council enacts as follows:

ARTICLE 1. Council is authorized to perform the resurfacing treatment on Harrison road, an estimate was prepared by the engineering department of the MRC Vallée-de-la-Gatineau project number ALCA-1601 dated March 23rd, 2016, including costs, net taxes and contingencies and is part of this by-law as Annexes "A".

ARTICLE 2. Council is authorized to spend \$432,471.88 for the purposes of this by-law.

ARTICLE 3. For the purposes of paying the expenses, Council is authorized to borrow a sum of \$432,471.88 that will be reimbursed with the Gas Tax grant (TECQ 2014).

ARTICLE 4. The work will be carried out as has been approved by the Programme de la Taxe sur l'essence et de la contribution du Québec (TECQ) 2014 to 2018 (Gas Tax) and will be reimbursed by the latter. The municipality must perform the work before being reimbursed.

ARTICLE 5. The municipality is authorized to take a temporary loan with the Caisse Populaire Desjardins for the full amount at an interest rate of prime plus 1%. Interest shall be paid monthly and principal will be paid when the municipality receives the payments from the 2014-2018 Gas Tax (TECQ).

ARTICLE 7. In the event that the amount of the allocation authorized by this by-law is higher than the amount actually spent, Council is authorized to use the excess to pay any other expenses decreed by this by-law and for which the allocation was deemed insufficient.

ARTICLE 8. Council accepts the payment of part or all of the debt, any grant payable over several years. The repayment term of the loan will be automatically adjusted to the time fixed for the payment of the grant.

ARTICLE 9. This regulation shall enter into force according to law
